Adoption of 403(b) Plan Document

BOARD RESOLUTION

Now, therefore, it is resolved by the Board of Trustees of Southern State Community College that:

- (A) The 2008 Resolution to adopt a 403(b) Plan document is rescinded in its entirety.
- (B) The College's Vice President of Business and Finance and/or the Director of Human Resources is authorized and empowered by the Board to adopt the 403(b) Plan document and is further empowered to make such administrative changes to the 403(b) Plan document as are required to effect compliance with the Final Regulations.
- (C) The College's Vice President of Business and Finance and/or the Director of Human Resources has the authority to sign the final 403(b) Plan document on behalf of this Board at any time on or before December 31, 2009, such 403(b) Plan document to be retroactively effective to January 1, 2009, with the corresponding full weight and effect.
- (D) All formal actions of this Board of Trustees relating to the enactment of this Resolution were taken and adopted in open meetings, and all deliberations of this Board or any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions, were in full compliance with the law.
